Site Location & Description

Glenbawn and Glendine Woods are two interconnected residential developments located in the townlands of Baun and Glendine on the northern edge of Kilkenny city. Glenbawn consists of 63 units – a mix of apartments, terraced and detached dwellings and Glendine Woods consists of 12 detached dwellings. Glendine Woods is accessed via the Ballyfoyle Road (L2612) with Glenbawn being accessed directly from the Castlecomer Road (R712).

Planning History

Planning permission was granted to South Eastern Tilt Up Ltd on 10th June 2004 for the construction of 75 housing units. The development commenced in October 2004.

TIC Request:

The formal taking-in-charge application was received from the developer on 21st November 2011. Subsequent to this, the Planning Authority engaged with the developer to progress the process and complete all remedial works as identified by the various service areas. All works have now been completed.

Recommendation:
