In response to queries from Members regarding the future of City Hall, Mr. Tim Butler confirmed that there will continue to be a presence for support to the Mayor, it will be the intention to move staff to the currently vacant offices in City Hall and Members will be kept informed of any future plans.

3. Proposed Control of Skips on Public Roads Bye Laws.

Mr. Seamus Kavanagh, A/Senior Engineer, gave a brief outline on the reason for the proposed Bye Laws to regularise indiscriminate dropping of Skips on public roads around the City. Draft Bye Laws were circulated to those present and Mr. Kavanagh requested the Members consent to proceed to public consultation stage.
